11.	Chairman's Report. We have had a quieter year with no big projects undertaken. Board Members watch over the area and report back to me or our very capable Secretary any problems that have been spotted.		
	The normal amount of weed control has been undertaken throughout the year. So Parrots Feather and Japanese Knotweed are dealt with as needed. New sluice boards are installed when necessary. We have concreted around the Great Sluice to make access easier.		
	I am sure that the very wet weather has been a hinderance, but luckily in the last months of the year the cattle have all been removed.		
	Several Marshes have been sold and new owners need to give names and addresses to us as there are certain restrictions for the use on the land. No areas can be used for camping or staying on the Marshes. The Board has a right to enter each Marsh, so that the channels can be inspected to make sure the waterways are clear and any work needed ca be carried out by our very efficient contractor. He has been dealing with the work for many years now.		
	Board Members have various tasks and take their work seriously, as it is part of their having a successful business.		
	Sue, our Clerk, works particularly hard and diligently for us. She makes my life easy, so "thank you Sue".		
	Councillors are appointed to the Board through North Devon District Council but this evening they are at a special Council meeting so can't be here with us. Members of the Boared rarely change but we have two new Members since last year. Welcome John and William. It is nice to have younger people on the Board.		
	The Board's financial position is good.		
	For those who have not attended an AGM before, please let me explain our set up:		
	People who own Marshes above a certain size can put their name forward to be a Board Member. Other people can be co-opted on, especially if they have particular skills that will benefit the Board.		

Braunton Parish Council Offices. Our meetings are held bi-monthly, where we discuss works needed to be carried out, manage our finances and review our Policies when needed. This is to achieve good management of the Marshes. There is a fascinating history as to how the channels were formed to allow the water to run freely for the cattle, who are turned out by April each year to fatten up etc. We look at all Planning Applications to make sure that they will not interfere with our work. We are so lucky where we live, the fauna and flora, wild animals and birds are very special and some are unique to Braunton Marsh 12. Clerk's Report and Accounts. I continue to enjoy my role as Clerk to the Board and recording the various activities carried out by Board Members, who devote a lot of time to ensure the water management is carried out in an effective way. The only frustration is when Marshes are sold and the Drainage Board is not told by the solicitors of the sellers or new owners of the change of details and it is often some time after that it comes to the Board's attention that there has been a change in ownership. It is important that the Board is kept up to date with changes so that the details can be updated and the Levy Invoice sent to the correct person. I would like to thank Board Members for the respect shown towards me as the sole employee and also for the duty of care for my wellbeing at all times.
